Exam Description: Cisco AppDynamics Associate Performance Analyst v1.0 (CAAPA 500-420) is a 90-minute exam. This exam certifies that candidates have the knowledge and skills to use AppDynamics technologies to monitor systems, applications, and business process performance; and to recognize, analyze, and remediate performance issues.
